The winners are:

1st Place: THE NAGGING SIREN by Teresa Choo (Chen Gao Kang), who is enrolled in the Master of Applied Science (Marine Environment) with Honours. - A siren powered by water ... emits a sound at this level may cause the seals to avoid this “discomfort zone”, which would be positioned in the area around the mouth of the trawl.

2nd Place: THE SEALYA LATER SYSTEM by Benoit van Rosserd ... - Uses mild DC electric currents travelling through ... net to deter seals from entering the net. ... mouth of the net the flexible wire could be sewn into the top and bottom of the net to form vertical lines that loo ... electric field and swim away.

3rd Place: THE ILLUMINATED by Jason McCarthy, who is enrolled in the Associate Degree in ... - Uses battery-operated lights which emit a dull light in the centre of the mouth of the trawl to act as a reference point for the seals to find an exit
